Town Hall Summary

The Town Hall began at 7pm and finished just prior to 9:30pm. The question and answer session covered the following topics:

- The Village needs a sign indicating that no engine brakes are allowed within the municipality.
- Update on the speed control efforts:
 - Scarecrow
 - Cat Eye
 - RCMP enforcement
 - ICBC Speed Control Education
- Long discussion on the topic of Resident only Parking.
- We need to ask Parks to put a sign up at the base of Sunnyside road letting people know when White Pine Beach parking is full.
- Updated progress on our water system and the water plan for Belcarra Park.
- We reviewed Belcarra's financial position.
- Updated everyone on the Speculation Tax efforts.
- Tree Trimming Committee provided an update.
- Revenue Generation Committee provided an update.
- Discussed brush management for fire prevention.
- Updated everyone on progress for improving Belcarra's building permit and inspection resources.
- Updated progress on the video system for online Council Meeting archives.
- Updated on Village flags and upcoming Coquitlam parade.
- Discussed idea about featuring a Belcarra resident each month on the new website.
- Updated everyone on the fire in Anmore this morning.
- Updated discussion about the Ward.
- Discussed requirement for interior sprinkler systems as a future requirement for new houses.
- Discussed potential of an ageing-in-place structure with amenities as a potential Revenue Generating Committee opportunity.
- Discussed the evacuation plan for both Belcarra and the area.
- Discussed the focus on Village water resources in the event of an emergency.
- Discussed the Port Moody Council developments.
